

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013 to 2014 and 2014 to 2015 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

At Hoxton Garden primary school we are committed to ensuring our children understand the importance of being active, having a healthy lifestyle and enjoy sports and games activities. In 2013/14 we will invest this money in:

- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with our teachers when teaching PE working in partnership with local secondary schools
- paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- teaching resources to help teachers to teach PE and sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- providing places for pupils on after school sports clubs and holiday clubs
- pooling the additional funding with that of other local schools to enable interschool competition
